CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES INFORMATION

When Controlled Substances or other opiates are taken for a course of treatment for acute or chronic pain, please be advised there is a risk of addiction and/or overdose associated with the controlled substance or opiates being prescribed, including, but not limited to:

- Controlled substances and opiates are highly addictive even when taken as prescribed
- There is a risk of developing a physical or psychological dependence on the controlled substance or opiate
- Taking more controlled substances or opiates than prescribed, or mixing sedatives, benzodiazepines, or alcohol with controlled substances or opiates can result in FATAL respiratory depression.

Although there are reasons why a Controlled Substance or opiate is beneficial and at times necessary; alternative treatments may be available in place of a Controlled Substance or opiate.
